### *Call for papers*

The Eurasia Humanism Research Group, from the University of Salamanca launches a Call for papers in the framework of its Research Project: Transversal Anthropology of Knowledge, funded by the *Junta de Castilla y León* (Spain), for the upcoming Workshop that will be hosted on **16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> March 2020**, in Salamanca (Spain).

Communications are meant to be divided into 7 themed roundtables, corresponding to the different research areas and the language specific roundtable that will be put into place to incorporate Japanese and Chinese communications. Otherwise, the communications will be presented in English or Spanish and should last no longer than 15 minutes.

All received applications will be checked by the Scientific Committee, formed by the Area Coordinators of the Research Group, using blind peer review.

The abstracts will be no longer than **250 words**, excluding the length for the bibliography notes. They **must** be submitted in **English and in the language to be used** in the communication.

The abstracts submission **deadline** is on **14<sup>th</sup> February 2020**, at 12:00 p.m. Spanish Peninsular Time. The resolution with the selected communications will be published no longer than Friday 21<sup>nd</sup> February 2019.
